# STATEMENT OF FAITH

The programs and activities governing the form of worship of Rhema West Christian Church shall be based upon and at all times be consistent with the following creed and beliefs.

1. We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments in their original writing as fully inspired of God and accept them as the supreme and final authority for faith and life.
2. We believe in one God, eternally existing in three Persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Father, conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary and is true God and true Man.
4. We believe that God created man in His own image; that man sinned and thereby incurred the penalty of sin which is death, physical and spiritual; that all human beings inherit a sinful nature which issues (in the case of those who reach moral responsibility) in actual transgression involving personal guilt.
5. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins a substitutionary sacrifice according to the Scriptures and that all who believe in Him are justified on the grounds of His shed blood.
6. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the Lord Jesus, His ascension into Heaven and His present life as our High Priest and Advocate.
7. We believe in the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ.
8. We believe that all who repent of their sin and receive the Lord Jesus Christ by faith are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God.
9. We believe in the working of the Holy Spirit, empowering and equipping believers for service, with the accompanying supernatural gifts of the Holy Spirit; and in fellowship with the Holy Spirit. We believe in the divinely ordained ministries of Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor and Teacher.
10. We believe that the one true Church is the whole company of those who have been redeemed by Jesus Christ and regenerated by the Holy Spirit; that the local church on earth should take its character from this conception of the Ministry spiritual and therefore, that the new birth and personal confession of Christ are essentials of Ministry membership.
11. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ appointed two ordinances – Baptism by immersion into water and the Lord's Supper – to be observed as a remembrance and proclamation of His finished work on the Cross. The Holy Communion is a celebration of Jesus' death and our remembrance of Him. Water baptism is an outward act that demonstrates a believer's identification with the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus.
12. We believe that divine healing is an integral part of the Gospel. We believe God wants to transform, heal and prosper us, so that we can live blessed and victorious lives that will impact and help others.
13. We believe that salvation is the gift of God to man. This gift is effected by grace through faith in Jesus Christ and it produces works pleasing to God.
14. We believe that elders are those called into five-fold ministry. They carry the responsibility for oversight and care of other staff and church members. Where necessary elders must carry out biblical discipline for the protection of the local church.
15. We believe in the principle of heterosexual relationships between a natural man and a natural woman within the confines of lawful matrimony.
16. The Ministry is open to any further truth, which the Holy Spirit may illuminate from Scriptures.
