## **Focus of today:**

Wisdom is available to anyone who is willing to look for it. God is not glorified when we fail and He has given us the blueprint to living life by design and navigate through the challenges that life can throw at us daily. We find that blueprint in the book of proverbs.

**WELCOME:** *Ice breaker:* Share the highs and lows of your week. Did something significant happen during the holiday?

**WORSHIP:** Do a praise and/or worship song as people shift their focus from each other to the Lord.

## **WORD:**

### **Proverbs 3:1-2 (AMPC)**

My son, forget not my law or teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments;

<sup>2</sup>For length of days and years of a life [worth living] and tranquility [inward and outward and continuing through old age till death], these shall they add to you.

Getting a revelation of what Jesus has done for us on the cross is the beginning of wisdom.

When we seek wisdom it will give three things to us:

1. **Length of days.**
2. **Long life, and**
3. **Peace**

## #1 Length of days.

- This refers to a literal day.
- The Hebrew word means a unit of time from sunset until the next sunset.

Q: Have you ever felt like you don't have enough hours in the day?

Q: How can wisdom help us when it comes to time.

## #2 Long life

- This phrase in Hebrew translates as JOY OF LIFE, LIVELY, VIGOROUS, FLOURISHING, PROSPEROUS, REVIVING!
- Not only will wisdom affect your daily life - it promises a long life worth living!

Q: Describe what Joy of life, a flourishing, prosperous and reviving life means to you.

Q: How does getting a revelation of what Jesus has done on the cross add good years to our lives?

## #3 Peace

- Peace is the Hebrew word shalom.
- It translates:
  - Peace
  - Prosperity
  - Success
  - Welfare
  - State of health
  - Friendliness
  - Deliverance
  - Salvation.

Q: When Jesus gave us His peace - He gave us all these things. What area of your life needs this peace?
